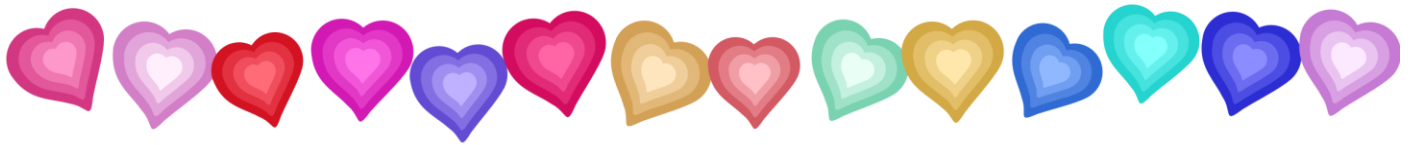
Prayer Shawl Group
