This past weekend was Memorial Day weekend, a time when we celebrate those who have served in our Armed Forces and given their lives in ultimate sacrifice. It is a truly important time of remembrance and gratitude. It also reminds us as Christians of the one who sacrificed all for our sake, Jesus Christ. God came to earth in human flesh,
