The Monthly Prayer Meeting will be on **Saturday, March 17th at 8:00 am**. Join us in praying for our church and our community!

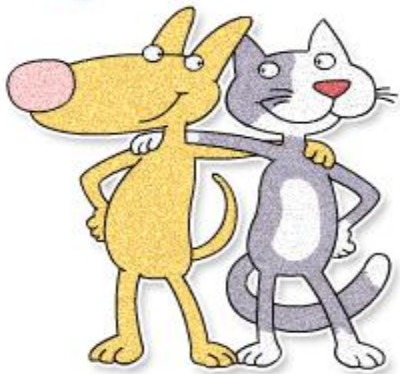
Visitation Team
